Our big 'Christmas gift' was moving into our home. Many volunteers from 12<sup>th</sup> Ave. CRC worked long hours to get their second parsonage ready for us. It is in beautiful shape. Dave's parents, with the help of Love INC and many friends, stocked and furnished the entire house, even with a Christmas tree! And our home church, Ridgewood, collected food items to help us stock our shelves on arrival. We were so moved by the generosity of so many people. We hope every returning missionary is cared for as well as we have been. We saw God's grace in action through his people in a beautiful way.

Before long we were knee-deep in work for the mission. Dave was stressed out about our two days of consultation meetings at the mission in mid-January, but discovered that they were a lot less grueling than he thought. We are now officially reappointed for service in Mexico City. Then we began the long preparation of sermons, slideshows, flyers and display table items for our meetings with churches, schools and supporters. Many details needed to be ironed out with churches about our visits with them (See our schedule on the other side).

## **Zzzz!** Cough! and Huh?

Health has been a concern for us here: we have been passing coughs and colds back and forth this winter. But that's the least of it - both of us went to a sleep disorder center for consultation. Blanca will be trying various medications until she finds one that works for her. Pray for her as she is pessimistic about the possibility of finding one. Dave is going to be "gaining weight" soon: he needs a hearing aid and a CPAP mask (for sleep apnia).

We had a nice week in Florida at the end of February. We visited our supporting church in Lake Worth (where Dave did his seminary summer internship in 2002), then we met up with Blanca's mother and splurged and took the kids to Disney World.
